TOTSKATE

Wednesday: 5:45 – 6:30 pm

- Learn fundamentals of skating (forwards, backwards, turn, stop, jump, spin)

CANSKATE

Monday / Wednesday: 5:45 – 6:30 pm

JUNIOR STARSKATE

Monday / Wednesday: 5:00 – 6:30 pm

Friday: 3:45 – 4:45 pm

- Group lessons on Monday / Wednesday teaching skating skills, dance & freeskate
- Participate in Stroking program with Senior Starskate
- Private lessons upon request

SENIOR STARSKATE

Monday / Wednesday / Friday: 3:45 – 5:45 pm

- Develop skills in skating skills, dance, freeskate and interpretive with opportunity to take Skate Canada tests.
- Private or semi-private lessons by certified Skate Canada coaches
- Skaters may attend recreational or qualifying competitions throughout the year

OTHER INFORMATION

PROGRAM ASSISTANTS

Many of our club's more advanced skaters assist with the instruction of CanSkate, TotSkate, and Junior STARSkate. They are trained to assist in these programs under the guidance of our professional coaches.

OUR SEASON

Our regular season runs from October 24th to the end of March (approximately 20 weeks).

OUR FEES

Various optional fundraising opportunities ensure that all programs are affordable for everyone. Fundraising opportunities are bingos, raffles, cookie sales, Mom's Pantry. As part of the commitment to the Clavet Arena, volunteer time is required in the kitchen throughout the year. This enables our ice fees to be reasonable.

OUR BURSARY FUND

Our bursary fund is available to all skaters competing in club sanctioned recreational and qualifying competitions.
